

**ERVIN TO ASK DELAY
IN REPORT BY PANEL**

CHARLOTTE, N.C., May 12 (UPI) — Senator Sam J. Ervin Jr., Democrat of North Carolina, said Sunday that he planned to ask the Senate Watergate committee, of which he is chairman, to delay its report to the full Senate until impeachment proceedings are completed by the Congress.

"I wouldn't want the report to come out at a time when the House has the question under consideration whether the articles of impeachment should be preferred against the President, or when the Senate is sitting as a jury in the case," he said at a news conference.

Senator Ervin said the tran-

scripts released by President Nixon week before last "are truly shocking because they show an effort to cover up what happened."

But he declined to identify who might be considered conspirators in the Watergate cover-up.
