

Impeach Vote Forecast by End of July

Washington

Congressional leaders of both parties spoke yesterday of a vote by the full House in July on the question of impeaching President Nixon.

Majority leader Thomas P. (Tip) O'Neill of Massachusetts and minority leader John J. Rhodes of Arizona also agreed that the Democrats have not intentionally delayed consideration of controversial proposals.

O'Neill said the impeachment vote will come the last week of July. Rhodes added, "I think we certainly should make every effort to have it at least by then."
