## Official Home for Ford

WASHINGTON, May 24 (AP) — Vice President Ford, under a compromise measure adopted by the House Armed Services Committee, would make an 81-year-old home his official residence while a new dwelling for United States Vice Presidents was built.

The committee voted, 26 to 5, yesterday, to use the old home on the Naval Observatory grounds here as temporary lodging for Mr. Ford and his family. The Fords now own their own home in suburban Alexandria, Va.

While approving a Senate measure for use of the old home, the committee struck out a Senate provision that would repeal Congress' authorization in 1966 for a new Vice-Presidential residence.
