WASHINGTON, May 28 (AP)—Jack Anderson, the columnist, reported Tuesday that Charles G. Rebozo, President Nixon's close friend, paid for nearly \$12,000 in improvements at the President's house in Key Biscayne, Fla., in 1969.

Gerald L. Warren, the deputy White House press secretary, declined to comment directly on the report but said that it "appears to us to be another leak out of

us to be another leak out of the Senate Watergate committee."

Mr. Anderson wrote that an Aug. 6, 1969 check for \$11,978.84, signed by Mr. Rebozo and drawn on his personal account, paid for electrical, air conditioning and painting work on Mr. Nixon's bayside home.
