**Kissinger Ducks Query
On His Threat to Resign**

OTTAWA, June 19—Secretary of State Kissinger sidestepped a question on his involvement in the wiretap inquiry and the Watergate affair today.

A questioner at a news conference have asked, "What is the status of that wiretap inquiry you requested and is it still your intention to resign if it is not cleared up?"

Mr. Kissinger said blandly, "As you know, I never comment on domestic affairs in a foreign country."

This produced roars of laughter from an audience that recalled that the Secretary had issued his threat to resign in Salzburg, Austria.
