The self-styled "bunch of nobodies" who organized tonight's Impeachment Ball said yesterday that tickets to the affair at the Sheraton Palace Hotel have all been sold.

The ball is intended as a parody of the Inaugural Ball in 1972 following the election of Richard M. Nixon. Five hundred people have paid \$10 apiece to attend.

Organizers of the 9 p.m. ball say that it is intended to emphasize that the Constitution is more important than the presidency. Proceeds go to the American Civil Liberties Union.
