By 57 to 36 per cent, the American people favor televising nationally the impeachment proceedings in the House of Representatives. By an even larger 59-to 34 per cent, a majority also would favor putting a U.S. Senate trial of the Presentatives. U.S. Senate trial of the President on TV.
