Buzhardt,

Nixon Counsel

Leaves Hospital

White House Counsel J. Fred Buzhardt, a principal architect of President Nixon's defense in the Watergate case, has been released from a hospital 15 days after a heart attack.

A spokesman at Fairfax Hospital in suburban Virginia said yesterday he was sent home Thursday.

Buzhardt, 50, was admitted to the hospital with chest pains early on the morning of June 13.
