

Ziegler Says**Nixon's Leg
Is OK**

Although President Nixon's left leg is still swollen, his phlebitis has "resolved itself," press secretary Ronald Ziegler said yesterday.

Ziegler commented on Mr. Nixon's condition as he showed reporters how the President puts the leg up on a chair to rest it in his Kremlin suite.

He said Mr. Nixon was piqued when he heard of news reports that he was "dragging" the leg Monday during and after his day-long tour of Minsk.

"Ask the press how they would feel if they were riding in a car for six hours," Ziegler quoted Mr. Nixon as saying. Ziegler said he, too, was stiff from the long rides.
