

Rodino target of trash in New Jersey

NEWARK (N.J.) — Rep. Peter W. Rodino, chairman of the committee looking into the impeachment of President Nixon, was met with a barrage of water, eggs and bottles as he toured a housing development in his district yesterday.

The incident occurred at the Columbus Homes during a tour of Newark housing conducted by Rodino and Mayor Kenneth A. Gibson.

No one was injured and there were no arrests.

One demonstrator said: "We heard Rodino was coming and we wanted him to know exactly what it was like to live here in crime and filth."
