Talk About

What He Said

President Nixon did discuss the perjury and conspiracy conviction of John D. Ehrlichman with Rabbi Baruch Korff Tuesday but does not feel he should comment while Ehrlichman's case is being appealed, a spokesman said yesterday.

Gerald Warren, deputy press secretary, confirmed Rabbi Korff's statement that Mr. Nixon had talked about the conviction of his former No. 2 aide in the Ellsberg break-in. But he declined to say whether Rabbi Korff had the correct impression that Mr. Nixon considers the conviction as "a blot on justice."

"We don't feel its appropriate to comment on the trial while it is still in the judicial process," said Warren. "It did come up in the conversation with the rabbi."
