## Howard Hunt Buys \$80,000 Miami Home

Convicted Watergate conspirator E. Howard Hunt says he's retiring to Miami to find privacy among his Cuban- American friends.

The former CIA agent, coordinator of the Cuban invasion at the Bay of Pigs, was convicted of helping plan the burglary and bugging of Democratic National Head-quarters in June, 1972. He was sentenced to 2½-to-8 years in prison and served ten months before being released pending appeal.

Hunt, 56, bought an elegant \$80,000, four-bedroom home with a swimming pool in the northeast section of Miami.
