Soviet Coverage Of Impeachment

The Soviet Union's reaction to the impeachment vote in the House Judiciary Committee Saturday was confined yesterday to a brief news account of a White House statement quoting the President as being "confident" the House will clear him.

The report, carried by

Tass news agency, was the first mention in the Soviet media of the climactic debate in the House committee. The decision of the Supreme Court last week ordering Mr. Nixon to turn over 64 tapes to Watergate special prosecutor Leon Jaworski was ignored altogether.
