Dole Suggests Increasing

Guard on Vice President

POMONA, Kan., July 28 (UPI)—Senator Robert Dole, Republican of Kansas, while refusing to comment on the House Judiciary Committee's vote recommending the impeachment of President Nixon, says that security surrounding Vice President Ford should be increased.

"It would be a tragedy of profound magnitude if something should happen to Ford that could be prevented by adequate security precautions and protection," Mr. Dole said at a campaign appearance Saturday night.

The former Republican National Chairman said that he hoped adequate security was being maintained because Mr. Ford would be President should the Congress impeach and convict Mr. Nixon.
