

# Belated Peking Report of Resignation

## Peking

The official New China News Agency, after 18 hours of silence on the Nixon resignation, reported the news last night in a 20-line dispatch.

The agency, which had never before mentioned Watergate, used the word in quoting Mr. Nixon's resignation remark that Watergate could cost him the congressional support necessary to carry out his presidential job.

The news agency also picked out from Mr. Nixon's review of his administration's foreign policy achieve-

ments the sentence: "We have unlocked the doors that for a quarter of a century stood between the United States and the People's Republic of China."
