Alger Hiss, the most famous target of Richard Nixon's post-war anti-communist investigations, said yesterday the President's resignation can mark "a new era of justice in our country."

In a brief statement to newsmen from his holiday residence here, Hiss said, "I would hope that this resignation will not diminish our people's search for truth which should continue without interruption."

"This can be the beginning of a new era of justice in our country which no one would welcome more than I," he said.

Mr. Nixon played a key role in the investigation of Hiss, a State Department employee who was accused of having passed documents to a communist agent. Hiss was convicted of perjury and jailed but never tried for espionage.
