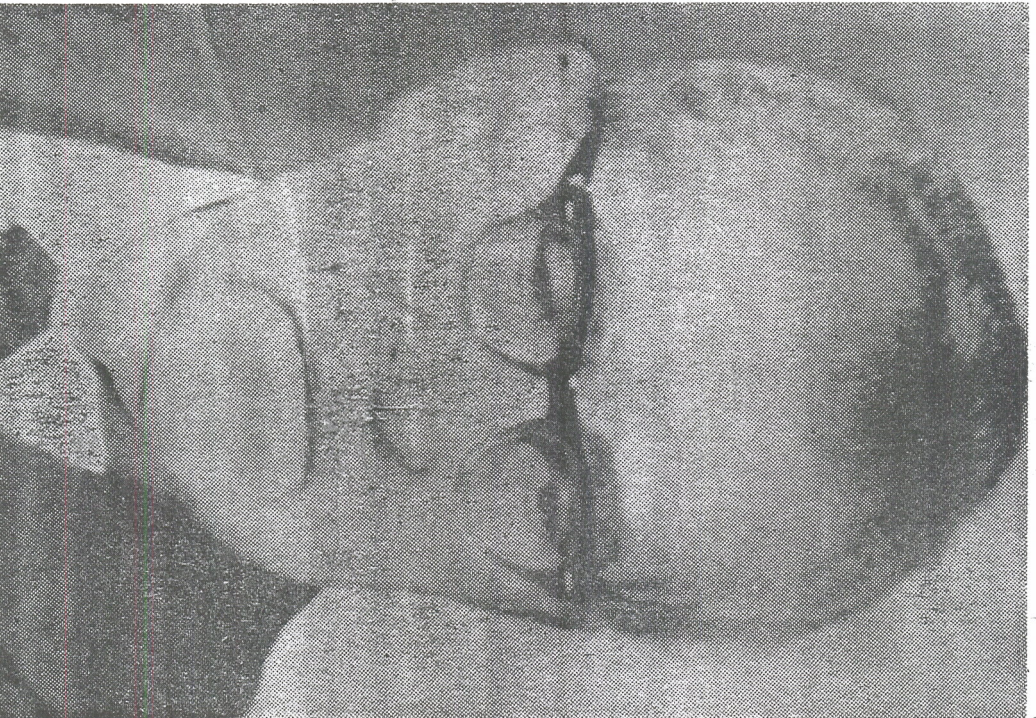
Nixon's Farewell to the White House
