The state Supreme Court suspended John D. Ehrlichman from the practice of law yesterday because of his federal conspiracy conviction.

The court ordered the suspension until final disposition of disciplinary proceedings which are expected from the Washington State Bar Association.

Ehrlichman, former President Nixon's top domestic adviser, was convicted in federal district court in Washington, D.C., July 31 in connection with the break-in at the office of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist.
