Ehrlichman Barred

From Law Practice

OLYMPIA, Wash., Aug. 9 (UPI) — The state supreme court suspended John D. Ehrlichman from the practice of law today because of his federal conspiracy conviction.

Ehrlichman, once President Nixon's top domestic adviser, was convicted in U.S. District Court in Washington, D.C., July 31 in connection with the break-in at the office of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist.

The court ordered the suspension until final disposition of disciplinary proceedings, which are expected from the Washington State Bar Association.
