Special U. S. Election Urged By Communist Chief Here

Gus Hall, general secretary of the American, Communist party, called yesterday here for an immediate Presidential

party, called yesterday here for an immediate Presidential election.

"Without such election, we will have a corporate-appointed, nonelected President and Vice President," Mr. Hall said in a statement printed in The Daily World, according to The Associated Press.

Mr. Hall called President Nixon's resignation "an historic step in the right direction," but he said the "financial industrial military complex" still runs the country.

"And at this very moment it is these same forces of monopoly capital, the corporate kingmakers, who have supported Nixon, who are making the decisions about replacement," Mr. Hall said.

He called for a "people's democratic movement" to achieve peace and prosperity.
