Suit Seeks Overturn

Of 1972 Nixon Victory

PHILADELPHIA, Aug. 10 (UPI)—Former President Nixon was named a defendant Friday in a \$25 million damage suit in federal court seeking to overturn results of the 1972 presidential election on grounds of "fraud and corruption."

The suit was filed by Kent Saldan, 35, who said he is chairman of the American Constitutional Rights Committee. Saldan said he is a public relations man and professional photographer.

The complaint, filed just two hours after Mr. Nixon left office, was submitted on behalf of the "American voters."
