**NIXON PUTS IN DAY
OF WORK ON COAST**

SAN CLEMENTE, Calif., Aug. 12 (AP)—Richard M. Nixon worked today in his office at the former Western White House, a spokesman said.

The overcast day here on the California coast was characterized as "a quiet one" for the former President as he began settling into the routine of wrapping up leftover White House affairs and planning his future.

His close friends, C. G. Rebozo and Robert Abplanalp, who had been visiting since Mr. Nixon flew here last Friday after resigning, left last night, the spokesman said. No new guests arrived.

The former President's daughter and son-in-law, Tricia and Edward F. Cox, remained at the 26-acre estate with her parents. The spokesman said the young couple had not decided how long they would remain here. Mr. Nixon's other daughter, Julie Eisenhower, is not expected to join the Nixons this week.
