Vows

Revenge

Rabbi Baruch Korff, one of ex-President Nixon's staunchest defenders, yesterday vowed that the National Committee for Fairness to the President which he heads will "tear the capital apart" to avenge the former President.

Rabbi Korff blamed some prominent newspapers and news magazines for demeaning the presidency in its "persecution" of Mr. Nixon.

Rabbi Korff, who did not elaborate on his threat, said his committee will wage a campaign to impose curbs on the media.

The rabbi, who is resuming his post as chaplain for the Massachusetts Department of Mental Health, told reporters he believes the "giants in the media" are "fearful of history judging them as assassins."

He said the New York Times, the Washington Post, Newsweek and the Los Angeles Times will not be satisfied until Mr. Nixon is behind bars. He said the former President was unjustly toppled from office.
