

No-Amnesty Stand**Applied to Nixon**

CHICAGO, Aug. 17 (UPI)—The commander in chief of the Veterans of Foreign Wars says neither Richard M. Nixon nor Vietnam draft evaders should be granted amnesty because "no man is above the law."

"A person cannot choose a law to obey," said Ray R. Soden, of Bensenville, Ill., the man who will play host to President Ford on Monday.

"No man is above the law from pauper to President."

Soden told a news conference Friday at the start of the VFW's 75th annual convention that the veterans' organization has "taken a firm stand against amnesty" for several years.
