

Burgling of Watergate Burglars

Two Watergate burglars who are developing a real estate project called Watergate Hills found the shoe on the other foot this weekend—someone burgled their construction site.

Police said Bernard Barker and Eugenio Martinez, who pleaded guilty of the burglary at Democratic National Headquarters in Washington's Watergate complex, reported that \$9000 worth of furniture and other equipment had been stolen.

Barker and Martinez announced last week that they would develop the project along with John Priestes, a Miami builder who recently served a sentence for falsifying a Federal Housing Authority sales agreement and rigging income tax returns to hide kickbacks to subcontractors.
