

St. Clair May Rejoin Firm

CHATHAM, Mass., Aug. 20 (AP)—James S. Clair, the former Presidential lawyer, said Tuesday that he has had discussions with his old law firm, Hale & Dorr, and may possibly rejoin it shortly. Mr. St. Clair resigned his post as a senior partner in the Boston firm in January when he was appointed special counsel to former President Richard M. Nixon during much of the Watergate investigation.
