Vote to Legalize Pot, Censure Ford

The Vermont Bar Association voted Saturday to support the legalization of marijuana and to criticize President Ford for pardoning former President Nixon.

The marijuana resolution stated that the drug could be sold through the state liquor stores to any person over the age of 18, subject to regulations governing "purity, potency and price."

The association, concluding a three-day meeting, called the Nixon pardon "an inappropriate intrusion into the legal and judicial process of the United States" because it came before the guilt or innocence of the former President was established through the judicial process.
