

Ex-Nixon Aide Transferred to Another Prison

Charles Colson, who was sentenced to prison after pleading guilty to obstructing justice in the Daniel Ellsberg case, has been transferred to a federal prison at Maxwell Air Force Base here.

Colson, a former special counsel to former President Richard M. Nixon, arrived at the minimum security prison Tuesday.

Colson, serving a one-to-three-year sentence, had been kept at Ft. Holabird, Md., waiting to testify at forthcoming Watergate trials. No reason was given why he was transferred at this time.
