

Why Julie Got A Free Flight

Julie Nixon Eisenhower flew to San Clemente yesterday on a government courier plane, a courtesy that has been accorded other former first families in the past, a White House military aide said.

Mrs. Eisenhower left on a Jetstar which also was carrying White House communications personnel and a

courier with the intelligence briefings which former President Nixon regularly receives.

William Gulley, executive director of the military office, said that courier planes fly to California every week or ten days in the continuing liaison between the White House and Mr. Nixon's home.
