Panel Urges Egil Krogh Be Disbarred

A disciplinary board of the Washington State Bar Association recommended yesterday that former presidential aide Egil Krogh be barred from practicing law in Washington.

The decision was a reversal of a recommendation in August by a state bar association advisory panel. That panel recommended that the 35-year-old former Seattle attorney be suspended from law practice for just nine months.

Krogh, a leader of the White House "plumbers" under former President Nixon, will have the chance to file a brief with the state Supreme Court, which has final review power over the action.
