## SFChronicle OCT 2 4 1974 Sentence Over For White House Copter Stunter

Robert K. Preston, the private who stole an Army helicopter and landed it on the White House lawn, has been released after serving two months at hard labor at Fort Riley, Kan., the Pentagon said yesterday.

Preston, 20, of Panama City, Fla., was given a general discharge for unsuitability.

He was sentenced in the February 17 incident to six months hard labor and forfeiture of \$200 a month for 12 months. The sentence was reduced upon review to two months and \$400 pay for forfeiture.
