Nixon Subpoena Hearing Is Set

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 25 (UPI)—A federal Judge has set a Nov. 11 hearing on whether former President Nixon—hospitalized only a few miles away—should be compelled to give testimony for use in a North Carolina Trial.

Mr. Nixon is already under subpoena to give a deposition at Santa Ana, Calif., about 25 miles from his home at San Clemente, on Nov. 26 for use at the Trial.

Mr. Nixon's attorney's filed a motion to quash the subpoena and after a telephone conference with attorneys involved U.S. District Court Judge William P. Gray set the hearing.

Awaiting trial in Charlotte, N.C., is a civil suit against high-ranking former Nixon aides brought by 21 persons who charged the White House took illegal actions against them.
