

Jaworski Denies Charge He Has Discussed Case

HOUSTON, Oct. 29 (UPI)—Leon Jaworski, the former special Watergate prosecutor, said today that charges that he had discussed the Watergate cover-up case on television panel shows were without foundation.

Defense attorneys in the cover-up trial said yesterday in Washington that they wanted Mr. Jaworski "to keep his mouth shut" about the case.

"I have not discussed the case," Mr. Jaworski said after returning to his Houston home from Washington. "It is clear that these charges are without foundation."

Mr. Jaworski said he had appeared on several television panel discussions but that he had not discussed the merits of the Watergate case. He also pointed out that the jury in the trial was sequestered and had no access to the news media.
