Big Probe of Rockefeller's Fortune

Washington.

Vice President-designate Nelson Rockefeller's fortune is so large and complex that 30 Internal Revenue Service agents have been needed to investigate it, members of Congress were told yesterday.

The investigation is being carried out by the Joint Committee on Internal Revenue Taxation for the Senate Rules Committee and the House Judiciary Committee, which will act on Rockefeller's nomination as vice president.

Joint Committee Chief of Staff Laurence Woodworth said the investigation will establish Rockefeller's net worth based on the fair market value of his stocks and bonds, real estate, trust funds, art, porcelain and silver.
