Rabbi Korff Asks Public  
To Leave Nixon Alone

WASHINGTON, Dec. 17  
(UPI)—Rabbi Baruch Korff asked Americans Tuesday, in the spirit of "peace on earth, goodwill to men," to leave former President Richard M. Nixon alone. If they do not, the Rabbi said, Mr. Nixon may die.

"I call for the suspension of all civil suits, of all legal harassment" against Mr. Nixon, said Rabbi Korff, who is the president of the National Citizens Committee for Fairness to the President.

The rabbi told a news conference here that if the former President was not left alone, he might die. Mr. Nixon is now recovering from phlebitis at his home in San Clemente, Calif.

"I state unequivocally that all these legislative, judicial and media actions literally emasculate Mr. Nixon," Rabbi Korff said. "The genius of medicine could in no way repair the incalculable damage being inflicted on this man."
