Milk Group Lawyer

Is Suspended Here

Texas lawyer Jake Jacobsen who pleaded guilty in August to paying former Treasury Secretary John Connally in exchange for his recommendation of an increase in milk price supports, was suspended yesterday from the practice of law here.

Chief Judge Gerard D. Reilly, of the D.C. Court of Appeals cited the plea to the felony charge in his order that suspends Jacobsen pending final action by the disciplinary board of the D.C. Bar.

Jacobsen faces a sentence of up to two years and a fine of up to \$10,000. He once served in the White House as legislative counsel to President Johnson and was a lawyer for Associated Milk Producers, Inc.
