San Clemente's 'Open Doors'

Ever since he spoke out against the Cambodian invasion in 1970, Oregon's Sen. Mark O. Hatfield hardly rated as one of Richard Nixon's favorite Republicans.

So imagine Hatfield's surprise on Christmas Eve when he picked up the phone to hear the former President wishing him the season's best. Nixon told Hatfield the "latch string" at San Clemente was always out, and the senator assured Nixon that the same was true in Newport, Ore., where the Hatfields have a home.

Says Hatfield, who last August had offered the services of his own administrative assistant to help out with mail at San Clemente following Nixon's resignation: "I felt a responsibility to reach out as one human being to another—and his response on Christmas Eve was genuine."
