College Withdraws

Ziegler Invitation

BOSTON, Jan. 27—A proposed lecture on "The Use and Abuse of Power" by former Nixon press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler was canceled today after strong faculty and student protests over paying Ziegler a \$3,000 fee.

After an hour-long forum at Boston University's School of Public Communication, the student government decided to rescind its invitation by a 14-to-5 vote.

"We have no right to condemn Ronald Ziegler, but we do have the right to condemn his fee," read the resolution. Student opinion, originally favoring the appearance, swung against it during discussion of the fee for the proposed Feb. 26 lecture. Printed signs saying "declare Ziegler Inoperative" were displayed at the school.
