Shipment order can be signed. Judge Richey also formally asked the chief judge for the District of Columbia Circuit to appoint two more judges to sit with him later this week and lear arguments in another related suit, this one dealing with documents of Richard M. Nixon to be shipped to the former President at his home in San Clemente, Calif. 4622

Judge Richey said he was prepared to approve shipment of the personal materials—excluding 17 folders that cover a "transition period" between Mr. Nixon's November, 1968, Presidential election victory and Jan. 20, 1969, when he took office for his first term.

But the judge put the burden on Mr. Nixon and his lawyers to secure agreement from the Court of Appeals so the final
