**Two Watergate
Figures Disbarred**

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 14 (UPI) — The California Supreme Court today suspended John D. Ehrlichman and Robert C. Mardian from the practice of law.

The court based its disbarment of the two attorneys on their convictions in connection with Watergate offenses.

Ehrlichman, an aide to former President Nixon, had been suspended earlier on the charges. The new suspension is for an indefinite period.

Mardian was chief of internal security in the Justice Department. He was convicted of conspiring to commit offenses against the United States in the Watergate affair. The California State Bar had recommended the suspensions.
