

Nixon to Attend Party

PALM DESERT, Calif., Feb. 21 (UPI)—Former President Nixon relaxed in the desert sun today and looked forward to a party Saturday night hosted by Walter Annenberg, the former U.S. ambassador to Great Britain.

Nixon and his wife drove here Wednesday from their home in San Clemente for a stay at the Annenberg estate.

The scheduled party for Nixon was described as a "reunion with old and good friends."

Among those reported on the guest list were Bob and Dolores Hope, Frank Sinatra, former Gov. Ronald Reagan and his wife, Nancy, Leonard Firestone and his wife and John Swearingen, chairman of

the board of Standard Oil of Indiana.

It will mark the first social event Nixon has attended since his resignation last Aug. 9. It also was the first time he had left San Clemente for more than a few hours since he was discharged from Long Beach Memorial Hospital last November following surgery for phlebitis.
