NIXONS ARE VISITING

ANNENBERG ESTATE

20 (UPI) — Former President Richard M. Nixon relaxed in the desert sun today and looked forward to his first social event away from San Clemente since his resignation last Aug. 9—a party Saturday night.

He and his wife drove here yesterday from their home in San Clemente for a stay at the estate of Walter Annenberg, former Ambassador to Britain, who will be the host of the party.

The party was described as a "reunion with old and good friends."

Among those reported on the guest list were Bob and Dolores Hope, Frank Sinatra, former Gov. Ronald Reagan and his wife, Nancy; Leonard Firestone and his wife and John Swearingen, chairman of the board of Standard Oil of Indiana.

This is the first time Mr. Nixon has left San Clemente for more than a few hours since he was discharged from Long Beach Memorial Hospital last November following surgery for phlebitis.

There have been occasions at dinner parties in San Clemente, including Secretary of State Kissinger, Senator Barry Goldwater and the Reagans.
