

**Guard on President's Homes
Would Be Reduced by Bill**

WASHINGTON, March 12 (UPI)—The House Judiciary Committee has approved a bill to control expenditures by the Secret Service on the protection of private Presidential homes.

The measure, approved yesterday, would also apply to the homes of Vice Presidents and

anyone else eligible for Secret Service protection.

The bill was a result of Congressional hearings into \$7-million spent by the Government on former President Richard M. Nixon's homes in San Clemente, Calif., and Key Biscayne, Fla.

The legislation would limit Secret Service protection to only one private residence for a President or other officials receiving protection.
