Peter Kreindler, counsel to the special Watergate prosecutor Henry S. Ruth Jr., told a panel of Federal judges hearing oral argument on Mr. Nixon's challenge that a quick resolution to the various suits relating to the Nixon materials was in "the public interest."

A panel consisting of two appellate judges Carl McGowan and Edward A. Tamm, and Charles B. Richey of District Court is considering the constitutionality of the law.
