White House Gate Crasher

### Is Sentenced to 18 Months

WASHINGTON, March 26 (UPI) — Marshall Fields, convicted of crashing a car into the White House gate, has been sentenced to 18 months in jail.

He was sentenced yesterday after a Federal court jury declared it was deadlocked on the question of his sanity at the time of the incident last Christmas Day.

Mr. Fields was convicted last week of destroying Government property by crashing a car through the White House gate. At the time, he was dressed in Arab clothing and threatened to blow himself up.

United States District Court Judge Gerhard Gesell, who ordered the sanity trial after Fields' conviction, said yesterday he would not schedule another hearing on the defendant's sanity.
