Court Bars Mitchell

Washington

The Supreme Court yesterday ordered former Attorney General John N. Mitchell and his former deputy, Robert C. Mardian, suspended from practice before the court, and gave them 40 days to show cause why they should not be disbarred permanently.

The two were convicted with White House figures John Ehrlichman and H. R. Haldeman in the Watergate coverup.
