

The Nixon Foundation Is Officially Dissolved

LOS ANGELES, April 11 (AP)—The Richard Nixon Foundation has been officially dissolved.

In an uncontested Superior Court action yesterday, the foundation was permitted to dissolve and donate its assets to Whittier College, the former President's alma mater.

The assets include some office equipment and oral history tapes dealing with Mr. Nixon's life before he entered politics, attorneys said.

Dissolution of the foundation, which was established in 1969 to set up a Nixon Presidential library, was approved by its trustees two months ago. The foundation had never selected a site for the library or engaged in fund raising.
