



Gurney Case to Jury

Former Senator Edward J. Gurney (Rep-Florida) took an elevator yesterday morning to the courtroom where his bribery-conspiracy trial was ending after 22 weeks of testimony. The jury, nine Democrats and three Republicans, deliberated four hours and ten minutes,

then recessed, forgetting to tell Judge Kretzman. The jurors left \$56,000 unattended. It was evidence in the case against Gurney, former President Richard Nixon's strongest supporter on the Senate Watergate Committee.
