Ex-Press Aide Says Nixon

Obstructed Justice on Tapes

WASHINGTON, Aug. 10 (AP) —Gerald L. Warren, deputy press secretary to President Nixon, said today that he believed that Mr. Nixon was guilty of obstruction of justice. Asked if he thought Mr. Nixon had committed any crime in connection with Watergate, he responded, "Yes I do, I do indeed."

He said the last set of tapes released by Mr. Nixon, needs on June 23, 1972, "clearly show obstruction of justice." He added, however, that he did not mean to say that Mr. Nixon should be brought into court. He said he was speaking of crime in the context of the impeachment inquiry that was then under way.
