"Of the millions of dollars worth of foreign gifts received by [Nixon] and his family while he was in office, apparently only one numismatic curiosity worth \$2 has been turned over to the federal government under the Foreign Gifts and Decoration Act of 1966....

"Although there are 1,100 packing crates of private and official foreign gifts to the Nixon family in 'courtesy' storage with the GSA, none have been formally turned over to the government as required by the law and must still be treated by the GSA as the Nixon's private property."
